
ORDER

On motion of Jeffrey R. MacDonald [DE-184],<sup>1</sup> the evidentiary hearing now scheduled for the week of October 31, 2011, is CONTINUED to **10:00 a.m.** on **November 28, 2011**, in the Alton Lennon Federal Building, Wilmington, North Carolina. The court has set aside that week for the evidentiary hearing, and, if necessary, will resume the matter upon conclusion of the court's regularly scheduled criminal term of court beginning on December 5, 2011.

The court believes that MacDonald's participation during the evidentiary hearing is warranted and in the best interest of justice. Accordingly, in its discretion, the court DIRECTS the United States Attorney to ensure MacDonald's transport, housing and attendance at the evidentiary hearing, beginning at 10:00 a.m. on November 28, 2011, and for as long thereafter, and at such times, as the court deems necessary to the best interest of justice.
