

¹ Mumma appeared as counsel of record for MacDonald “solely with respect to [his] . . . request for DNA testing pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3600 (The Innocence Protection Act.” Clarification of Notice of Appearance [DE-280]. Attorney M. Gordon Widenhouse is still an attorney of record for MacDonald, but he is appearing in this action with respect to his claims pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255. *See* Notice of Appearance [DE-244] (stating that he was entering a notice of appearance “for the purposes of the evidentiary hearing on remand of this matter from the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit on defendant’s motion under 28 U.S.C. § 2255”). Attorney Keith Williams also is an attorney of record in this case, but it is unclear from the record whether he is appearing in this matter solely with respect to MacDonald’s § 2255 claims, or whether he also is appearing with regard to MacDonald’s Innocence Protection Act claims. *See* Notice of Appearance [DE-282] (“NOW COMES the undersigned who does hereby enter this Notice of Appearance on behalf of Jeffrey MacDonald in the above-captioned case.”).
